



GOVERNMENT AUTHORIZATIONS and LIAISON SERVICES

LOCAL MOVES (AFI32.6001, para 11.10.1.1)

Local moves from community housing to privatized housing are paid on a one-time basis after PCS.

IMPORTANT: In order to guarantee this benefit you must provide a minimum of **48 hour** notice to the housing referral office for processing. *Move orders **MUST be obtained by Government housing personnel prior to move in order to receive a government paid move. Additionally, you cannot change the type of move (drayage to DITY or vice versa) without new orders from the government housing office.***

STORAGE OF EXCESS HOUSEHOLD GOODS (NTS) Member is authorized government paid storage of *delivered* Household Goods (HHG) IAW AFI 32-6001, paragraph 11.10.2.3 that are excess to needs while occupying Privatized Housing (PH). Requests and storage list of items must be provided to the Government Housing Management Office (HMO) within **30 days** of move-in to PH. The military member is responsible for making necessary arrangements for storage of *approved* HHG items and **MUST** pick up a signed copy of their orders from the HMO. If orders are not picked up within 30 days of signing, regardless of failed attempts to contact member, they will be rescinded and any stored items will be at the member's own expense.

NOTE: These benefits can only be authorized by the Government Housing Management Office and not Hunt Military Communities. Be sure to visit your Government Housing Office at the Hunt Community Center to determine your eligibility, or email:

NON-TEMPORARY STORAGE ON PCS (JFTR 5.1.2). Responsibility is with the member and the local TMO office for removal or continued storage of HHGs on PCS orders. The housing office is not financially responsible for PCS storage costs and cannot authorize continued benefits.
