SUBJECT: Buckley AFB Environmental Program Guidance

1. Whether directly or indirectly, every activity conducted on Buckley AFB impacts the environment. In accordance with ISO 14001, *Environmental Management Systems*; AFI 32-7001, *Environmental Management*; and DoDI 4715.17, *Environmental Management Systems*, Buckley AFB is committed to leadership and stewardship in protecting the environment, the prevention of pollution, and continual improvement. These are primary responsibilities of each person utilizing or working on the installation in any capacity.
2. To this end, Buckley AFB commits to environmental excellence by:

 - h. Providing the framework to set and review environmental objectives and targets.
